FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 12, 2010

Educational programs for school groups will be held on Friday, February 12th, 2010 at the Olustee Historic State Park. Programs are scheduled between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Education possibilities for the day include the Park's Interpretive Center, authentic medical demonstrations, period encampments and artillery demonstrations.

When you arrive, you will be directed to park your bus/vehicles along U.S. Highway 90. Students **must** enter the front gate. We suggest a chaperon for each 10 students. Learning activities and a map identifying the educational stations will be mailed to you after your registration is received. Stations will feature interpretation of specific areas (for example: Confederate and Federal Camps, Artillery and Medical.) There will also be informative programs under the Ball Tent.

A Teacher's handbook of learning activities, that you can use in your learning centers or as supplemental materials, is provided free of charge. This handbook is correlated with the current Sunshine State Standards and includes some of the same formats that are on the test.

There are many grassy areas for picnicking. Food concessions items will also be available. You will be responsible for carrying all lunch items to the picnic area. We ask that you limit the number of vehicles that you bring by carpooling.

Admission is \$2.00 per person, payable at the time of entrance.
